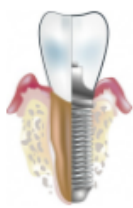

What is a Dental Implant?

- A dental implant is a small titanium screw secured in the jawbone that serves as the replacement for the root portion of a missing natural tooth.
- The titanium's special property will fuse to bone which allows the dental implant to stabilize the bone preventing bone loss and maintaining its shape and density.
- The implant then serves as an anchor for the replacement tooth or teeth (single crowns, bridges or dentures).
- Dental implants are surgically placed into the jaw and can be placed in either the upper or lower jaw.
- Dental implants can be used in solutions for replacing single or multiple missing teeth.

When both the tooth and root are both damaged, the best permanent replacement is a dental implant in conjunction with a ceramic crown. This technology has become as much of an art form as it is a corrective dental procedure since it has such an overwhelming effect on an individual's appearance which improves their self-esteem.
